Scholarship Criteria: (Applicants may apply for either the Shivers or Coleman Scholarship, but not both)

Selection of the scholarship recipient will be based on the criteria listed below.

Please provide written documentation for the following:

- at least 5-10 years of progressive experience in the community college
- an understanding and appreciation for the community college mission and its students
- progressive advancement toward leadership positions within the community college system
- letter from your supervisor, indicating the extent to which the institution will support your participation financially
- complete and return the information form below
